Liver cancer patient

A lady, who is 58 years old, had liver cancer came to our centre for adjustments. Her doctor had stopped all treatments for her as she was too weak to continue any form of treatment. When she first arrived at the centre, her stomach was swollen and had to rely on colonic irrigation to clear her bowels. In addition, she had to spend about RM6,000 every month on health supplements. After 3 months of continuous adjustments, she could clear her bowels naturally and her appetite improved as well. After 1 year of adjustments, the swelling of her liver and stomach improved greatly and her conditions overall also improved tremendously.

Cyst growth

A lady in her mid 40's had a lump above the lymph node in her left thigh. Her doctor informed her that it was a watery cyst that had to be removed surgically. We provide adjustments for her with special emphasis on the charka 2 and the growth. After about 2 months, she felt a painful sensation at the growth but a few days later the cyst disappeared.

Adjustments for animals (cobra, hornets and fish)

1) Cobra: One day, while I was in my farm, I found my dog sniffing excitedly at a net. Upon investigation, I found a cobra coiled up inside the net, which was meant for harvesting prawns. The snake was unable to escape. I wanted to free the cobra but was afraid of been bitten. It was very risky. On the 3rd day, I decided to “communicate” with the cobra, teaching it to go somewhere else and not harming anyone, using the techniques thought in the senior Longevity class. Interestingly, by the 4th day the snake was gone.

2) Hornets: My wife had accidentally disturbed a nest of hornets while harvesting bananas. She was stung on her head and arms. I perform adjustment for her on the 6th and 7th charkas in addition to the stung and swollen parts of her body. She could sleep peacefully and soundly that night. By the next day all the swellings were gone. I went near the hive and performed adjustments from a distance of 2 feet and “communicated” with the hornets to look for food elsewhere. A week later the swarm had shifted leaving an empty hive behind.

3) We have a small aquarium at home, where my son kept his pet “flower-lou-han”. The fish became sick. It was hardly moving nor eating and slowly turning vertical and dying. I moved the fish to a bucket of water and perform adjustment for it 3 times. It finally recovered became lively again.
